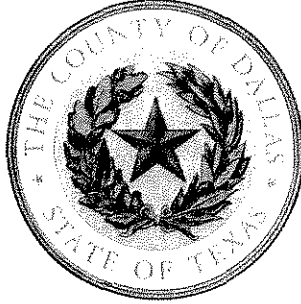


Resolution

BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Dallas County, Texas, held on the 1st day of February, 2011, on motion made by Clay Lewis Jenkins, Dallas County Judge and seconded by Maurine Dickey, Commissioner of District No. 1, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, heart disease is the number one killer of women and one in four American women dies of heart disease; and

WHEREAS, many women do not know that heart disease is a woman's problem and they do not take it seriously; and

WHEREAS, the risk factors for heart disease are smoking, high blood pressure, high cholesterol, being overweight, obesity, physical inactivity, diabetes, a family history of early heart disease, and age; and

WHEREAS, women can promote their own heart health and prevent disease and illness by taking steps to prevent and control the heart disease risk factors; and

WHEREAS, keeping women healthy and promoting awareness of women's health issues, including heart health, is an important responsibility and depends on the actions of many organizations and groups in our community; and


WHEREAS, women's health remains a priority for families, communities, and government, and our commitment to keeping women healthy is stronger than ever; and




WHEREAS, Dallas County women need to take action to make heart health a priority for themselves and their families, become aware of their heart disease risk, and take action to control their risk;
