Qualifications

The minimum requirements for the exam are as follows (all required work experience must be with the Dallas County Sheriff's Department). Must have successfully maintained all State and Sheriff's Department licensing/commissioning requirements and the following:

- High School Diploma or GED AND
- Served at least two(2) years as a Dallas County Sheriff's Deputy III - (Sergeant) and have at least sixty (60) hours of college from an accredited college or university with a grade "C" or better in each class OR
- Served at least two (2) continuous years as a Dallas County Sheriff's Deputy III - (Sergeant), and two (2) years of continuous military service with honorable discharge and have at least thirty (30) hours of college from an accredited college or university with a grade "C" or better OR
- Served six (6) continuous years as a Dallas County Sheriff's Deputy III - (Sergeant)
