Qualifications

The minimum requirements for the exam are as follows (all required work experience must be with the Dallas County Sheriff's Department). Must have successfully maintained all State and Sheriff's Department licensing/commissioning requirements and the following:

- H.S Diploma from an accredited high school or a GED AND
- Served at least two(2) years as a Dallas County Sheriff's Detention Service Supervisor (DSS) and have at least sixty (60) hours of college from an accredited college or university with a grade "C" or better in each class OR
- Served six (6) continuous years as a Dallas County Sheriff's Detention Service Supervisor (DSS)
- MUST be TCOLE Certified as an Intermediate Jailer or able to attain such certification within six months of employment.
