Overview

- 1938: constructed at a cost of \$1,750,000
- 1942: became a Federal Detention Station for the Immigration and Naturalization Service
- 1969: incarcerated offenders sentenced under the Youth Corrections Act
- 1980: Federal Prison Camp; perimeter fence was installed
- 1996: Federal Detention Center
- 2001: FCI Seagoville, Satellite Camp
- 2013: National Register of Historical Places



Correctional Programs Unit Management

- Develops activities and programs designed to appropriately classify inmates.
- Victim Witness, WITSEC, Inmate Financial Responsibility, Release Preparation (Reentry), and case management.
- Promotes the skills necessary to facilitate the successful reintegration of inmates into their communities upon release from federal custody.

Religious Services

- The Religious Services Department has two distinct divisions: 1) religious accommodation and pastoral care.
- The Faith Based Reentry Program is designed around Character, Interpersonal Relationships and Daily Living .
- Annually, marriage retreats are conducted; inmates and spouses study *The 5 Love Languages* together.



Recreation Department Wellness Program

- Offers innovative, interesting and structured wellness and leisure activities to meet “At Risk” inmates’ needs.
- Inmate wellness program activities includes screening, assessments, goal setting, fitness/nutrition prescriptions and counseling.
