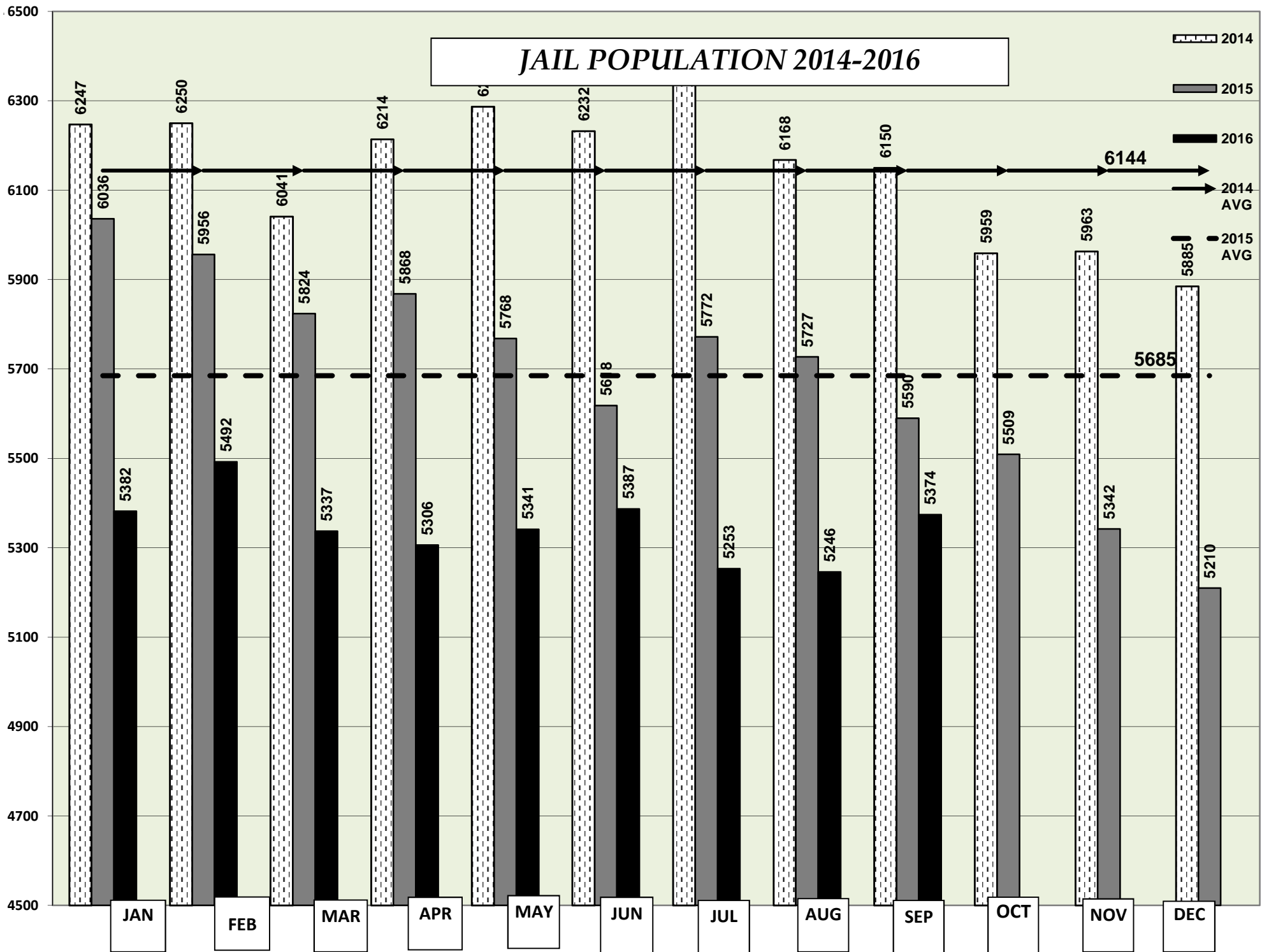

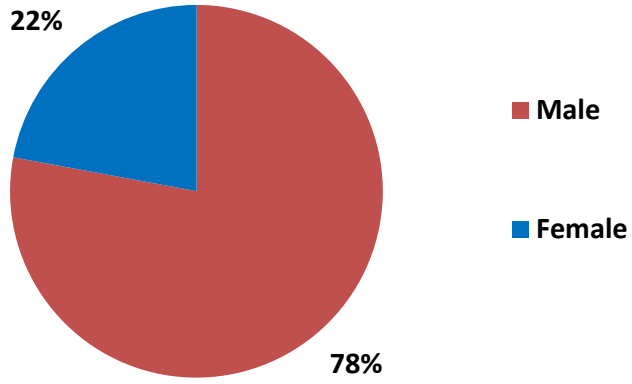

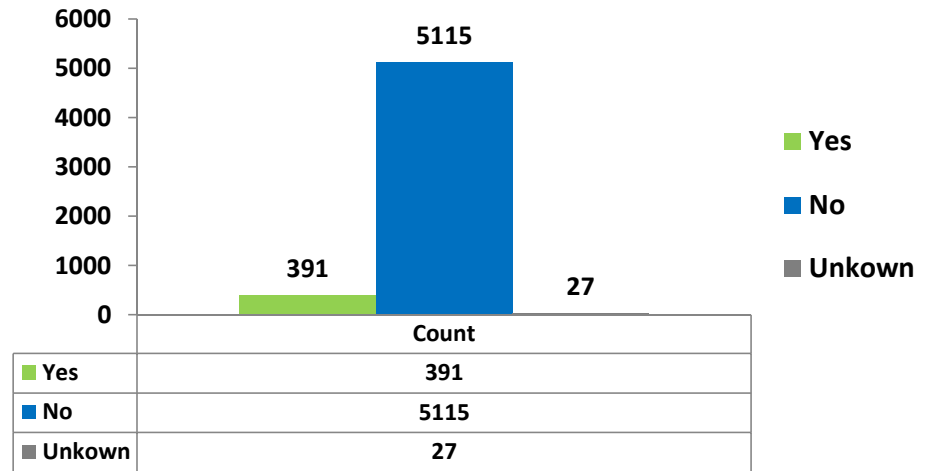

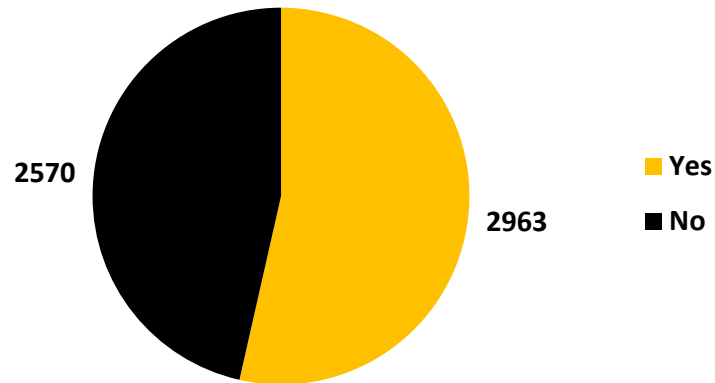
September 2016 BookIn Gender

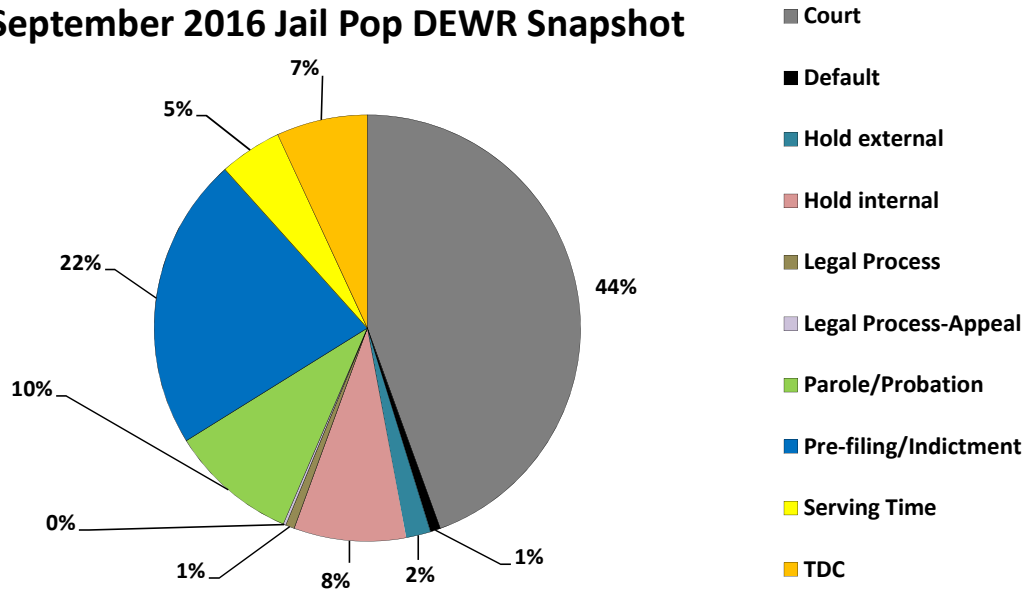

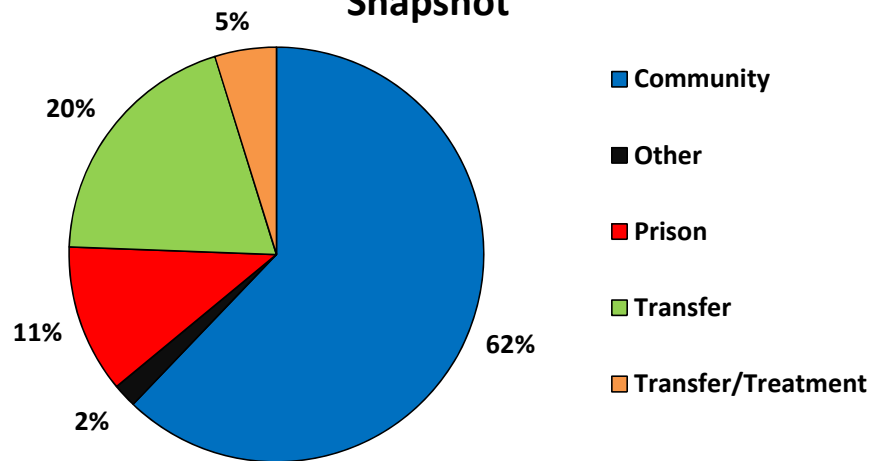
Past 3 Months of 2016 vs September 2016 Release Destination Snapshot

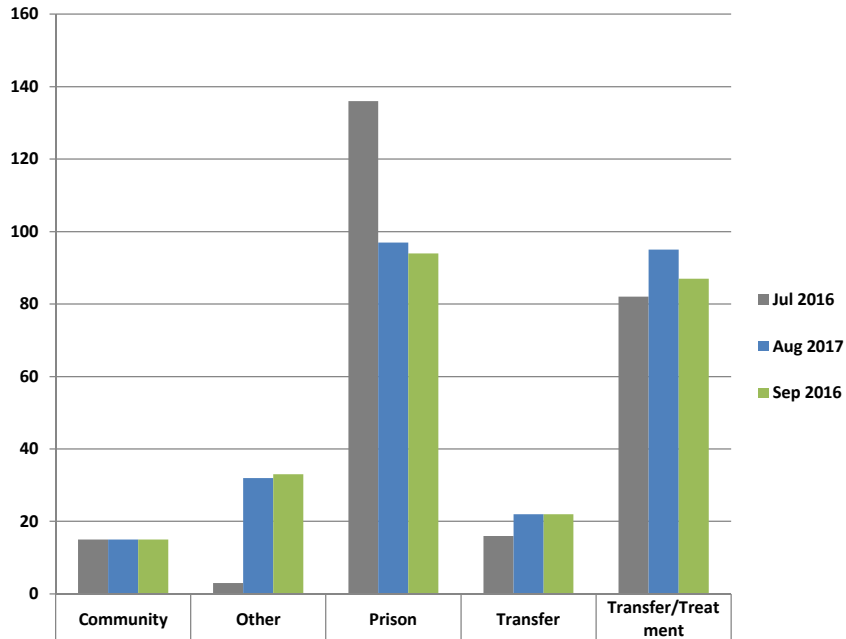
