EMERGENCY HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (EHAP)

FUNDED THROUGH CARES ACT

Provides short-term rental, mortgage, and utility assistance to low income Dallas County residents living outside of the City of Dallas economically affected (loss/reduction of income) by the spread of COVID-19.



- Applicant must be 18 years of age or older to apply

We encourage and support an affirmative advertising and marketing program in which there are no barriers to obtaining housing because of race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status, or natural origin.

Applications processed through a lottery system

Pre-screening applications will be accepted on-line beginning Friday, July 24, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. (CST) and end on Thursday, August 20, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. (CST)

Length of assistance not to exceed 3 months

ELIGIBILITY

- Must reside outside the city of Dallas but within Dallas County;
- Currently not receiving housing assistance through another entity;
- Household income is less than 80% of AMI; and
- Must have suffered an economic impact due to COVID-19.
