Effective Thursday, June 1, 2023, Justice Court Precinct Four Place 1 will implement MANDATORY E-FILINGS of ALL cases. Paper case filings will no longer be accepted after May 31, 2023.

All Pro Se litigants (parties not represented by an attorney) and attorneys will be required to submit new Eviction, Small Claims, Debt Claims, any subsequent case filings and any other response via E-file Texas Self-Help or E-File Texas. Any litigant not having online computers capabilities will have access to the computer kiosk in the Justice Court office/lobby. Any cases not accepted by E-file Texas Self-Help or E-File Texas will have to be submitted in person.
