("SCRA") THE SERVICEMEMBERS CIVIL RELIEF ACT

The Service members Civil Relief Act ("SCRA"), 50 App. U.S.C.A. § 501, et seq., is a federal law signed by President Bush on December 19, 2003, which imposes certain procedural requirements in civil cases to protect members of the armed services and their families. These requirements apply to any court of any state whether or not the court is a court of record. 50 U.S.C. App. § 511(5).

A. Does the SCRA Apply in Eviction Cases?

- B. Requirements for a Default Judgment
- In any case in which the defendant does not make an appearance, before entering a judgment for the plaintiff the court "shall require the plaintiff to file with the court an affidavit: (A) stating whether or not the defendant is in military service and showing necessary facts to support the affidavit; or (B) if the plaintiff is unable to determine whether or not the defendant is in military service, stating that the plaintiff is unable to determine whether or not the defendant is in military service." 50 U.S.C. App. § 521(b).
- If the plaintiff fails to file an affidavit under the SCRA in an eviction case, the court may not grant a default judgment. Likewise, if the plaintiff files an affidavit stating that the defendant is not in military service, but fails to "show necessary facts to support the affidavit," the court may not grant a default judgment. Typically, plaintiffs will attach a printout from the Department of Defense website: https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/appj/scra/scraHome.do but they are not required to use that form as long as they show "necessary facts" to support the affidavit.

The SCRA does not apply to criminal cases.

- If a proper affidavit is filed, there are three possibilities:
- The defendant is not in military service: the court may enter a default judgment
- The plaintiff is unable to determine whether or not the defendant is in military Service: (the court may enter a default judgment and may - but does not have to – require the plaintiff to post a bond to protect the defendant if it turns out that s/he is in military service.
- The defendant is in military service: the court must appoint an attorney to represent the defendant.
