

BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Dallas County, Texas, held on the 15th day of March, 2011, on motion made by Clay Lewis Jenkins, Dallas County Judge and seconded by John Wiley Price, Commissioner of District No. 3, the following Resolution was adopted:


WHEREAS, each year brings the potential for violent weather to Texas; and

WHEREAS, Governor Rick Perry has declared the week of March 14-18, 2011 as Flood Safety Awareness Week in Texas; and


