- I. <u>Call to Order</u>: John Dornheim, Planning & Priorities Chair, opened the meeting at 9:02 a.m. The meeting was called to <u>order</u> at 9:19 a.m.
- II. <u>Certification of Quorum</u>: Quorum was established by John Dornheim and certified by Logane Brazile, RWPC Coordinator.
- III. Introductions/Announcements: None.
- IV. <u>Approval of the October 20, 2021 Minutes</u>: Lori Davidson made a motion to approve the minutes. Helen Zimba seconded. The motion passed.
- V. Office of Support Report: Logane Brazile, RWPC Coordinator, reported the committee has 15 seats, of which 7 seats are filled, and 8 seats are vacant. He reported the committee's representation & reflectiveness of the HIV epidemic within the community as follows:

The 1st group impacted with the highest numbers is Blacks at 10,111 or 42% representation;

• The P&P committee membership consists of 7 people of whom 4 are Black with representation at 57.00% reflectiveness.

The 2nd group impacted with the next highest numbers is White at 6,598 or 27% representation;

• The P&P committee membership consists of 7 people of whom 2 are White with representation at 29.00% reflectiveness.

The 3rd group impacted with the next highest numbers is Latinx/Hispanic at 5,839 or 24% representation;

• The P&P committee membership consists of 7 people of whom 1 are Latino/Hispanic with representation at 14.00% reflectiveness.

Ryan White Planning Council has 33 seats 17 are filled with 53% non-aligned consumer representation. HRSA requires 33%, non-aligned consumers.

- VI. <u>Linkage to Care Presentation</u>: Grace Balaoing, DCHHS, provided an overview of the Dallas County Sexual Health Clinic Linkage to Care program. Linkage to Care is a program primarily focusing on establishing connectivity with HIV+ individuals with limited evidence of HIV-related medical care. The program assists with newly diagnosed individuals as well as those who may have fallen out of care. Balaoing described components of the program such as source of patients, the intake process, follow up procedures, program success rate statistics, and the sexual health clinic PrEP program for those who test negative for HIV.
- VII. Standards of Care Recommendation: Glenda Blackmon-Johnson, RWPC Office of Support, initiated conversation regarding the FY 2022 Service for Incarcerated Population Matrix created in response to numerous questions about the allocation of funds to provide services for recently incarcerated individuals. The purpose of the discussion being to determine how to better support planning for recently incarcerated through the Linkage to

Care program. The matrix included sections with topics regarding the difference between jails and prisons, Dallas County Operations Linkage to Care, and other community-based Linkage to Care programs. She mentioned further information pertaining to direct Linkage to Care from jails would be available during this month's Evaluation Committee Meeting on November 23, 2021 via guest speaker Daron Kirven of Prism Health North Texas.

Glenda Blackmon-Johnson, RWPC Office of Support, shared her screen briefing the overview and purpose of the FY 2020 Standards of Care and Service Delivery Guidelines. Sub-sections containing corrections made during previous meetings were reviewed prior to introducing new sub-sections for commentary made under **Appendix B: Units of Service and Billing Limitations**.

The floor was then opened to the committee for immediate suggestions or changes to the document. Committee members provided multiple suggestions for revisions under each sub-section. Several modification suggestions included inserting language regarding virtual visits with and without video during the public health emergency and drafting standard language appropriate for all service categories to maintain formal consistency throughout the document.

Portions of each sub-section were highlighted in the document to be revised in preparation for the following committee meeting. The committee reviewed the following sub-sections:
