- I. <u>Call to Order</u>: Helen Zimba, Chair, opened the meeting at 9:00 am and called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.
- II. <u>Certification of Quorum</u>: Quorum was established by Helen Zimba, Chair, and certified by Logane Brazile, RWPC Coordinator.
- III. <u>Introductions/Announcements</u>: John Dornheim announced the World AIDS Day event at Dallas County Health and Human Services building on December 1, 2022. Participants can contribute a design for the World AIDS Day quilt that will hang inside the building. The CQM team has been working on a poster symposium to showcase the outcomes of the sub-recipient's Return to Care project. The Office of Support, alongside the Administrative Agency, will be hosting a quilting activity on December 1, 2022, in honor of World AIDS Day. Del Wilson, Resource Center Dallas, introduced Jamie Linares Alexander, DDS, a dentist for the Resource Center of Dallas.
- IV. <u>Approval of November 8, 2022, Minutes</u>: Lori Davidson motioned to approve the minutes Donna Wilson seconded. The motion passed.
- V. <u>Office of Support Report:</u> Logane Brazile, RWPC Coordinator, reported the committee has 15 seats, of which 7 seats are filled and 8 seats are vacant. He reported the committee's representation & reflectiveness of the HIV epidemic within the community as follows:
 - The 1st group impacted with the highest numbers is Blacks at 10,111 or 42% representation.
 - The P&P committee membership consists of 8 people of whom 6 are Black, representing 74.00% reflectiveness.

The 2nd group impacted with the next highest numbers is White at 6,598 or 27% representation.

- The P&P committee membership consists of 8 people of whom 1 are White with representation at 26.00% reflectiveness.
- The 3rd group impacted with the next highest numbers is Latinx/Hispanic at 5,839 or 24% representation.
- The P&P committee membership consists of 8 people of whom 0 are Latino/Hispanic with representation at 0.00% reflectiveness.

Ryan White Planning Council has 33 seats 25 are filled with 33% non-aligned consumer representation. *HRSA requires 33%, non-aligned consumers.*

- VII. Standards of Care Review for Change: Justin Henry, GM, reported no significant updates. The Standards of Care will be available for public comment/review in January 2023. Del Wilson, alongside Jamie Alexander DDS, provided Standards of Care feedback regarding the Oral Care cap justification noting that the cap should be expanded from \$3,000 to \$5,000 or \$6,000 over two years. The second recommendation would be to utilize usual and customary fee percentages to avoid undercharging for extensive procedures or overcharging for simple procedures. There has been discussion regarding raising the FDL for dental from 300% to 400% to serve more patients and avoid under-expenditure of funds.
- VIII. <u>New Business:</u> Logane Brazile, Office of Support, noted that Lori Davidson would provide her annual housing report at January 14, 2023, Planning Council meeting.
- IX. <u>Adjournment</u>: Helen Zimba, Chair, made the motion. Lori Davidson seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 9:19 am.
