- I. Call to Order: John Dornheim, Evaluation Committee Chair, called the meeting to order at 3:01 p.m.
- II. <u>Certification of Quorum</u>: Quorum was established by John Dornheim, Chair, and certified by RWPC Coordinator.
- III. Introductions & Announcement: Helen Turner made the following announcements:

Joni Wysocki, AHF/AIN

- The Texas Strikeforce will be holding a meeting with Imelda Garcia on March 24, 2022, to answer any questions from sub-recipients or consumers.
- The Texas HIV Medication Advisory Committee will meet on April 8, 2022, from 1:30 p.m.-to 4:30 p.m. Consumers and the community will be able to provide feedback.
- The Legacy Grace Project will be hosting its annual Nation Conference for Women Living with HIV from April 29, 2022, through May 1, 2022. Those interested in attending should visit LegacyGraceProject.org for registration details.

Glenda Blackmon-Johnson, RWPC Manager, announced the RWPC Leadership Orientation for committee members would be held on April 13, 2022, from 9 a.m.-to 12 p.m. The training is available for Planning Council and standing committee members only.

Kellie Norcott, PHHS, announced that beginning on Monday, March 28, 2022, Parkland's Maple Avenue Garage would begin charging patients a certain amount of money to park based on time increments. Validated parking is available for those seeking HIV-related medical care at the ACCESS Clinic or Moody Outpatient Center.

Joni Wysocki, AHF/AIN, announced that the AHF Pharmacy would be hosting a COVID Booster Clinic at the Market Center location off Stemmons Fwy. The clinic will take place on March 30, 2022, from 8 a.m.-to 12p.m/ 1p.m.-5p.m. No appointment is necessary.

- **IV.** <u>Approval of February 22, 2022, Minutes</u>: Helen E. Turner motioned to approve the minutes. Norma Piel-Brown seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
 - V. Office of Support Report: The Office of Support reported the following regarding the Evaluation Committee Membership Reflectiveness: Evaluation Committee (15 seats): 9 members (6 seats vacant). The 1st group impacted by the HIV epidemic with the highest numbers is Black at 10,111 or 42% representation; the Evaluation Committee membership consists of 9 people, of whom 3 are Black with representation of 33% reflectiveness. The 2nd group impacted by the HIV epidemic with the highest numbers are Whites at 6,598 or 27% representation; the Evaluation Committee membership consists of 9 people of whom 5 are White with representation at 56% reflectiveness. The 3rd group impacted by the HIV epidemic with the next highest numbers are Latin/Hispanic at 5,039 or 24% representation; the Evaluation Committee consists of 9 people of whom 1 is Latino/Hispanic with representation at 11% reflectiveness.
- VI. <u>FY 2021 Assessment of the Administrative Mechanism Report</u>: Jasmine Sanders, RWPC Planner, began a review of the EAM report updates stating that the report is primarily used to assess how quickly and well the RWPC Part A recipient carries

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out the process to contract with and pay providers for delivering HIV services so that the needs of PLWH throughout the Dallas EMA are met. The primary focus being to update the document with new detail, committee members are given discretion regarding providing suggestions for necessary changes. The committee reviewed the procurement/RFP process, Agency #1-10 Executed contract dates for HRSA, contract monitoring process, procurement matrix, FY 2021-2022 Part A Formula Expenditure Report, and Part A Award: Contract Renewal and RFP Award Timeline 2021.

The committee held an extensive discussion regarding suggested recommendations to the AA, which include:

- Brief sub-recipients on major programmatic changes they may expect ahead of time to ensure better communication.
- Provide training on any changes to the RFP; the AA should include purchasing personnel.
- Periodically communicate openly with sub-recipients regarding long-range plans for the grants program.

The AA has noted these recommendations and will be considered in the future.
