DCHHS opens new public health clinic in North Dallas

Dallas County Health and Human Services officials announced yesterday the opening of a public health clinic in North Dallas where children's immunizations and refugee services will be offered.

The clinic, located at 8202 Spring Valley Road, Suite 200, in Dallas, will be open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. DCHHS is planning a ribbon-cutting ceremony and a reception at 10 a.m. Friday.

Immunizations will be offered for a flat fee of \$10 per child for the first visit and \$5 for any subsequent visits. Immunizations are free for those with valid Medicaid cards.

Appointments for immunizations aren't necessary.

This clinic location replaces the facility DCHHS opened and operated at 2445 W. Northwest Highway in Dallas. That clinic is now closed.

DCHHS' former refugee clinic was located at 7317 Holly Hill Drive before the staff was moved to this new location on Spring Valley Road.

"Taking this approach of combining two areas of services under one roof in a community where they are much-needed was cost-effective," said DCHHS Director Zachary Thompson. "We are glad to be able to provide these services to residents in this community."

The clinic is located in a residential neighborhood near two major thoroughfares, Interstate 635 and U.S. Highway 75.

Clients will find the clinic housed in a brand new building, one suite down from a Texas WIC office. The entrance to the parking lot for the clinic is just south of Spring Valley Road and is accessible from Waterfall Way. Waterfall Way intersects Spring Valley Road.
