The Dallas County Purchasing Department has received and hereby provides for general information purposes only the following questions and the County's responses.

(Note: Due to time constraints, Dallas County will not be responsible for ensuring confirmation vendor receipt of this and/or any further acceptance of and/or responses to future questions prior to the bid opening date.)

Question No. 1: **Can we bid on UV germicidal lamps only? Your item number 104, 105, 106, 107 & 108. The item #107 & 108 is asking for Voltarc lamps no substitutions. Voltarc is not in business anymore. What should I do?**

Response: *Yes. You can bid on only the UV germicidal lamps, items 104-108, if you choose. I was not aware that Voltarc is no longer in business and due to time constraints, am unable to verify your statement. However, you are permitted to bid any manufacturer(s) that meets the specifications.*

Question No. 2: **Insurance? We do have warranty on these lamps. Do we need to purchase insurance for supplying these lamps?**

Response: *Any vendor that conducts business with Dallas County, whether it is for goods and/or services, must maintain the stipulated minimum insurance described in the subject bid during the term of the contract.*
