The Dallas County Tax Office has made your 2013 Current Property Tax Statement available to you electronically via email. All that is needed is a few minutes to enroll at: www.dallascounty.org by clicking on **Online Payments** then **Pay Property Taxes** to look up your account. It's that simple!

The process is free of charge, easy to enroll and saves paper, time and money.
