- Your payment by Money Order, check, or Credit Card, is due at the time of your request. There will be not extension. (Check with the appropriate Court for the payment amount).
- Copy of your current Texas Driver’s License.

**\*In accordance with CCP 45.051, if you are 17 years of age and hold a provisional driver license during the deferral period, you will be required to be examined by the Department of Public Safety and present evidence of compliance along with a Certificate of Completion of a Driving Safety Course by the end of your deferral period. There will be a \$10.00 fee payable to the Department of Public Safety for the examination.**

**\*In accordance with CCP 45.051, if you are between the ages of 18 and 24, you will be place on a 90 day deferral period and be required to complete a Driving Safety course. You must present a Certificate of Completion of a Driving Safety course by the end of your deferral period.**

**ORDER DEFERRING FINAL DISPOSITION PURSUANT TO SECTION 45.051  
OF THE TEXAS CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE (DISCRETIONARY)**

THE COURT further ORDERS that if, at the conclusion of the deferral period, the Defendant has complied with the imposed requirements, the Court shall dismiss the complaint with no final conviction being entered, and the complaint may not be used against the Defendant for any purpose.

THE COURT further ORDERS that if, at the conclusion of the deferral period, the defendant has failed to comply with the requirements, and the COURT shall proceed to enter a final conviction of guilty.
