OBSERVER EXPECTATIONS

INTERACTION WITH DCDRC:

- AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED <u>TO BE ON TIME FOR THE MEDIATION</u> THAT YOU AGREED TO OBSERVE. ATLEAST <u>24 HOUR NOTICE IS REQUIRED FOR YOUR CANCELATION</u> OF INVOLVEMENT.
- AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED TO <u>MAINTAIN PROFESSIONALISM</u> WITH THE DCDRC, CLIENTS, AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER THE MEDIATION IN WHICH YOU ARE OBSERVING. <u>PROFESSIONAL ATTIRE</u> IS ALSO REQUIRED WHEN OBSERVING MEDIATION OR INTERACTING WITH THE DCDRC.
- AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED TO ADHERE TO <u>ARTICLE VI. EMPLOYEE</u>
 <u>STANDARDS OF CONDUCT</u>, WHILE ENGAGED IN VOLUNTEERING ACTIVITIES FOR THE DCDRC.
- AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED TO CHECK IN WITH THE DCDRC STAFF UPON
 <u>ARRIVAL AND WAIT IN A DESIGNATED WAITING AREA UNTIL YOUR MEDIATION BEGINS</u>. THE
 DCDRC STAFF MAINTAINS ACCESSIBILITY FOR YOU TO COMMUNICATE WITH THEM; HOWEVER
 INTERACTION IS EXPECTED TO BE CONSIDERATE OF THE STAFF'S TIME TO COMPLETE THEIR
 WORK RESPONSIBILITIES. PRIMARILY, <u>EMAIL</u> IS ENCOURAGED TO COMMUNICATE WITH DCDRC
 STAFF, TO MAXIMIZE CUSTOMER SERVICE FOR CLIENTS.
- AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED TO ADHERE TO THE <u>MODEL STANDARDS OF</u> <u>CONDUCT FOR MEDIATORS</u> FROM THE AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION, AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER FOR THE DCDRC.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

- AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED TO SIGN IN ON THE **SIGN IN SHEET**.
- AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED **TO INTRODUCE YOURSELF TO THE MEDIATOR** BEFORE INTERACTING WITH THE PARTIES.

DURING MEDIATION:

 AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED TO <u>NOT ENGAGE IN THE MEDIATION</u>. YOU ARE NOT THE MEDIATOR! YOU MAY ONLY ENGAGE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PRESIDING MEDIATOR. • AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED TO MAINTAIN THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF PROFESSIONALISM WHILE IN THE MEDIATION. YOU WILL NOT BE A DISTRACTION TO THE MEDIATION PROCESS. SOME EXAMPLES COULD INCLUDE; CHEWING GUM, SLEEPING, EATING, ETC. IF YOU ARE A DISTRACTION, A MEDIATOR MAY ASK YOU TO LEAVE THE MEDIATION.

AFTER THE SESSION:

- AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED TO COMPLETE A <u>MEDIATOR EVALUATION</u> FORM.
- AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED TO TELL CLIENTS THAT YOUR WORK IS
 COMPLETED AT THE END OF MEDIATION. YOU ARE EXPECTED TO <u>END YOUR INTERACTION</u>
 WITH THE PARTIES UPON COMPLETION OF THE MEDIATION, TO AVOID CONFLICTS OF
 INTERESTS AND/OR ETHICAL ISSUES. SOME EXAMPLES COULD INCLUDE; WALKING PARTIES TO
 COURT CLERKS, WALKING OUT OF THE BUILDING WITH ONE PARTY, SCHEDULING SERVICES AT
 THE PARTIES PLACE OF BUSINESS, ETC.
- AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE EXPECTED TO <u>ADHERE TO THE CONFIDENTIALITY</u> OF YOUR CASE. DO NOT DISCUSS PRIVATE OR PERSONAL CONCERNS FROM THE MEDIATION IN PUBLIC.
- MEDIATOR WILL REPORT TO THE DCDRC THEIR EVALUATION OF THE OBSERVER.

COMPLIANCE

AS A VOLUNTEER OBSERVER YOU ARE <u>EXPECTED</u> TO FOLLOW THESE EXPECTATIONS. FAILURE
TO DO SO COULD RESULT IN <u>TERMINATION OF YOUR VOLUNTEER SERVICE</u> WITH THE DCDRC.
