The misuse or misapplication of shared resources or the supplantation of existing resources with shared assets is prohibited. 6. **Audit Report.** Audits will be conducted as provided by the Single Audit Act Amendments of 1996 and OMB Circular A-133. The Department of Justice and Department of the Treasury reserve the right to conduct periodic random audits.
