The following amendment to the Procedures and Rules Manual of the Dallas County Bail Bond Board, August 2022, was adopted on, May 10, 2024:

Page 2-3

Rule: I.B.1.d.

Annual Election of the Presiding Officer and <u>Annual Elections for All Board</u> Representatives.

- c. The Board shall conduct an annual election of the Presiding Officer at the Regular January Meeting of the Board.
- (1) Any Board member may nominate any other Board member. Board members may self-nominate but non-Board members may not participate in the nomination process. The nomination must be accepted by the nominee and the nominee must be present at the meeting.
- (2) The Presiding Officer shall be elected by a simple majority vote of the quorum present. In the event of a tie the same procedure will be repeated until the tie is broken or a candidate withdraws from consideration. Any ballots cast become the property of the Board.
- (3) The Presiding Officer shall serve a term from the date of the election in January, through the date of the next election in January of the following year.
- (4) The Board may vote to remove a Presiding Officer for cause with 2/3 vote of members present after notice and show cause hearing.
- d. Annual Elections for the Surety, Criminal Defense and Justice of the Peace Representatives.
- (1) Pursuant to Tex. Occ. Code Ann.§ 1704.0535, the annual secret ballot elections for the following representative positions shall be held:
 - a. The first Tuesday of December for the licensed bail bond surety or agent for corporate surety board representative;
 - b. The first Thursday of December for the Justice of the Peace board representative;

- c. The second Tuesday & Wednesday of December for the Criminal Defense Attorney board representative.
- (2) This rule amends the dates established by rules II.D, E, & G.
- (3) The terms for the Surety, Criminal Defense and Justice of the Peace Representatives shall run from January through December.
- (4) This amendment is to be incorporated into rules II.D, E. & G upon the next revision of the DCBBB Procedure and Rules.
