

Challenges and Opportunities

- New Legislation, specifically HB718, has placed a huge burden on County Tax Offices. The main cost in this legislation will be to accept AND allocate metal plates to licensed dealers. This legislation was put in place to prevent paper tag fraud. Dallas County has over 2,600 licensed dealers. The logistics of allocating, and distributing, license plates to each of these dealers is large and time-consuming.
