# MDHA Holds 2019 State of the Homeless Address

On Thursday, March 14, 2019, the Metro Dallas Homeless Alliance (MDHA) held its 5th annual signature meeting, at Goodwill Industries of Dallas, to share the results of the of the 2019 Homeless Count, progress of the Homeless Response System, and the vision to end homelessness in our community. The address was delivered by Carl Falconer, MDHA President and CEO.

The State of Homeless Address (SOHA) collectively reviews data and derives knowledge about the nature and extent of homelessness. The SOHA also gives an honest assessment of the system and the progress toward ending homelessness. The assessment helps in making the decisions on how to move forward and build an effective homeless response system. Lastly the SOHA provides an opportunity for ideas and insights from all on how to make homelessness rare, brief, and non-recurring in our community.

With an overall increase in homelessness of 9% for the second year in a row, Carl Falconer encouraged stakeholders in Dallas and Collin Counties to work toward a single vision for ending homelessness by ending his address with a call to action: "I'm done managing homelessness. I'm done hearing that Houston is the only city that does anything about homelessness in Texas. I'm done hearing that Dallas can't end homelessness. I'm done stepping over people sleeping on the sidewalks. I'm done talking about what to do to end homelessness. It's time to do it."

#### Homeless Count Results:

**Overall homelessness** in Dallas and Collin Counties, clocking in at **4,538** individuals, rose by **9%**, when compared to 2018. **Unsheltered homelessness**, clocking in at **1,452** individuals, rose by **23%** during the same time period. The number of **homeless veterans** increased by **10**, from **331 to 431 (11.3% of all homeless individuals)**. The number of **chronically homeless** individuals (those homeless for a year or more, with a documented disability) increased by **11%** from **424 to 470**.
