

**BE IT REMEMBERED**, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Dallas County, Texas, held on the 12th day of August, 2014, on a motion made by Dr. Theresa M. Daniel, Commissioner of District #1, and seconded by Mike Cantrell, Commissioner of District #2, the following Resolution was adopted:


- WHEREAS**, the Dallas/Fort Worth Metroplex is growing at an astounding rate, increasing to over 9.8 million residents by the year 2035; and
- WHEREAS**, the current transportation infrastructure in North Texas is insufficient to handle the growing demand placed on it by the increase in population and commerce; and
- WHEREAS**, the Interstate Highway 635 East project, from United State Highway 75 to Interstate Highway 30, is essential to the future of the region creating economic development, promoting safety and redevelopment opportunities, impacting the City of Dallas, Dallas County and state of Texas; and
- WHEREAS**, the LBJ Express project, from US 75 to IH-35 E, is currently under construction, adding capacity to increase mobility in the northern portion of Dallas County; and
- WHEREAS**, the IH-635 East project will greatly impact the county by enhancing access and connectivity to Garland, which is one of the region's largest industrial areas; and
- WHEREAS**, Dallas County has joined the coalition the City of Garland has organized including the cities of Dallas and Mesquite, State Legislators and US Congressional Members representing the IH-635 East corridor who are all supportive of the IH-635 East project; and
- WHEREAS**, members of the IH-635 East Legislative Coalition have made their support for the IH-635 East project known through a letter dated May 16, 2014, and
- WHEREAS**, US Department of Transportation Secretary Anthony Foxx expressed his support for the IH-635 East project at his Bus Tour Press Conference on April 18, 2014, and


