- WHEREAS, CC Young started with 10 residents in 1927 and now proudly meets the needs of hundreds of seniors by offering unique residential options such as independent living, assisted living, memory care and more. - WHEREAS, Today, the CC Young vision continues with the expansion of housing services and the opening of the Hospice General Inpatient wing in The Vista in 2019, which is an innovative healthcare amenity new to the North Texas area; and
- WHEREAS, The Dallas County Commissioners Court joins the CC Young Senior Living community and residents in celebrating this momentous occasion. May CC Young continue the vision to enrich the lives of many more seniors for 100 more years and beyond.
