BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Dallas County, Texas, held on the 21st day of June, 2022 on a motion made by Dr. Theresa M. Daniel, Commissioner of District 1, and seconded by Dr. Elba Garcia, Commissioner of District 4, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, Designing History is the new exhibit at the Sixth Floor Museum at Dealey Plaza and is the culmination of a year-long partnership between the Museum and Dallas ISD's Career Institute East Interior Design program, which serves students from six different high schools in Dallas; and

WHEREAS, The installation was designed collaboratively by students for the Museum's historic spaces and features 23 artworks that range from collage to painting and drawing to multi-media installations; and

WHEREAS, The artwork is inspired by the students' in-depth learning experience with the Museum through virtual field trips and research conducted during the 2021-2022 school year. The works on view explore President Kennedy's life and legacy and his lasting impact on the city of Dallas, the place they each call home; and

WHEREAS, The students embraced the challenge of sharing the story of someone they had never met and events that occurred decades before they were born for a place they had never visited. Each student created an artwork on topics including the life and legacy of President Kennedy, issues of the 1960s and the city of Dallas. The 23 pieces selected for the exhibit reflect the lasting connections the participants made between their lives and the lasting impact history has on the world today.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dallas County Commissioners Court applauds the efforts of the DISD Career Institute East Interior Design students to study history and its ripples into the future through art displayed in the Designing History special student exhibition that runs through July 3, 2022.
