- WHEREAS, In 2023, the national theme "Secure Our World" was introduced, and continues again in 2024 to reinforce the collective responsibility we all share in safeguarding our digital environments, underscoring the importance of taking simple, actionable steps to protect data and systems in our daily lives; and
- WHEREAS. Dallas County remains committed to bolstering its cybersecurity posture by investing in technologies, enhancing employee awareness through training, and promoting cybersecurity best practices across all sectors, including government, business, and public institutions; and
- WHEREAS, Residents, businesses, and organizations are encouraged to visit the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) website at cisa.gov for further resources, tips, and tools on how to enhance their cybersecurity practices and protect themselves from evolving cyber threats
