Senior Center Month

WHEREAS, Senior Center Month, observed nationally each September, celebrates the vital role senior centers play in supporting the health, well-being, independence, and social engagement of older adults; and

WHEREAS, Senior centers provide access to critical programs and services, including nutrition, fitness, transportation, educational opportunities, social activities, and community resources, thereby enhancing the quality of life for participants; and

WHEREAS, First established as Senior Center Week in May 1979 and expanded to a month-long observance in 2007, Senior Center Month is sponsored by the National Institute of Senior Centers and the National Council on Aging to promote awareness and engagement in programs that empower older adults; and




