According to the Texas Department of Health & Human Services, in 2022, an estimated 19,921 women in Texas will be diagnosed with breast cancer, and an estimated 3,415 will die from it. Commissioner Garcia encourages everyone to be proactive in staying healthy by getting screened now to be informed, to prevent, to treat and to understand those who are going through the different levels of this disease.

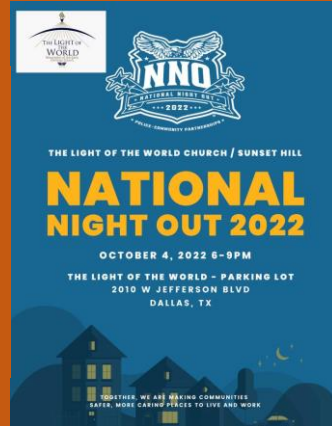
