Wildlife Parkway Groundbreaking Ceremony in Grand Prairie

On October 25, 2022, elected officials, and community members joined me in the groundbreaking of the Wildlife Parkway. A 55.9M project in partnership with the City of Grand Prairie, the Regional Transportation Council and Dallas County. This project will include 2 bridges, a 12 ft foot wide trail and sidewalks that will connect with SH 161 and Belt line. This improved roadway provides a critical new route for fire and police response between two busy thoroughfares. The project provides regional connectivity, including the regional bike and hike trail from Dallas to Fort Worth. We are ready to go!
