Parkland Hospital Announces Increased Homestead Exemptions



Parkland Hospital recently announced its support for raising the homestead exemption from \$69,000 to \$100,000. This increase benefits Dallas County residents that are over 65 and/or disabled, by providing a tax relief from the increase in the property values. It also aligns the County and Hospital exemptions to be the same. Additionally, Dallas College also increased their exemptions from \$75,000 to \$100,000 on May 2nd. Dallas Central Appraisal District (DCAD) is the agency in charge of doing all property values and is not part of or work under Dallas County.

Oak Lawn Place - Senior Affordable Housing

Resource Center, in partnership with Dallas County, broke ground for Oak Lawn Place, an 84-unit senior housing development for those 55 years and older. Dallas County contributed \$5 Million in ARP Funds through our affordable housing program for this project. The building will be within walking distance of DART's Inwood Road/Love Field commuter rail station. A full-time Resource Center employee will work at the site to coordinate activities and services alongside the property management group, Volunteers of America Texas. Resource Center CEO Cece Cox said, "the new community will be one of hope, perseverance and love."







Coombs Creek Trail Delayed to Save Endangered Species





Last month, an endangered Red Tail Hawk with its 2 chicks and 1 egg were discovered in one of three trees that are slated to be removed for the Coombs Creek Trail. The construction was put on hold until the nest is vacated by the resident bird family. The president of the neighborhood stakeholders was informed and wholeheartedly agrees with the recommendation of the City of Dallas' Senior Biologist to delay any work within 150-foot radius of the nest as federal government mandates. The total delay is anticipated to be from 45 to 60 days. This was an excellent call as we need to protect our endangered species. DCHHS Offers Free AC Window Units for Qualifying Households
