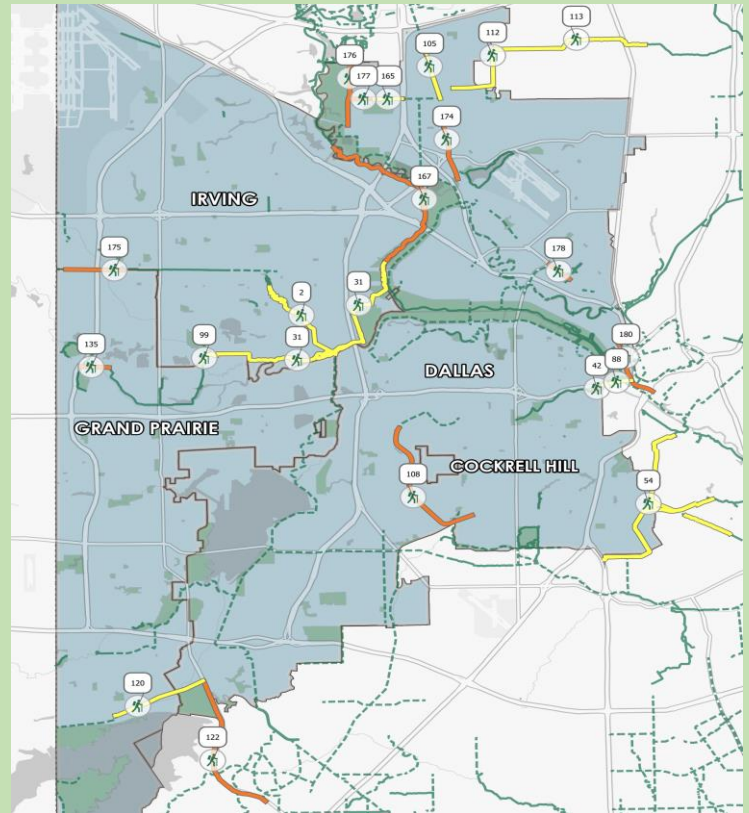


Your back to school list should include vaccines
