This state-of-the-art, 37,000 sq. ft. facility, located at 1010 W. Mockingbird Lane in Dallas represents a \$40 million investment in our community's safety.

Equipped with cutting-edge communication systems, advanced data analytics tools, and modern infrastructure, this new center will enhance our emergency response capabilities, ensuring better coordination and faster response times. 


