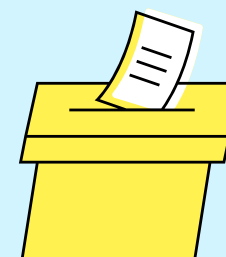

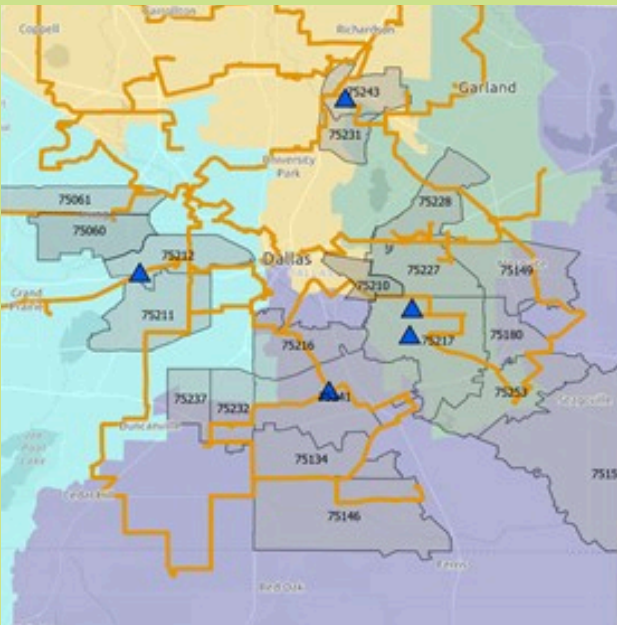

DALLAS COUNTY EXPANDS INTERNET ACCESS WITH \$28M ARPA FUNDING

Dallas County is investing \$27.8 million from the American Rescue Plan Act to expand high-speed internet access infrastructure. Zayo, a communications infrastructure provider, will help us build and enhance over 60 miles of middle-mile fiber network, targeting 10 high-priority zip codes. This expansion will enable high-speed internet access for approximately 24,000 households, fostering economic growth and innovation. With nonprofit Compudopt, Zayo will also support digital literacy and access by providing 300 laptops with two years of tech support for Dallas County students.

The Dallas County Health & Human Services Department urges everyone to remember and follow the **FOUR D's**:

DEET- Apply insect repellents, containing "deet" or other EPA-approved ingredients, as directed, when outdoors.

DRESS- Wear long, loose, light-colored clothing to cover exposed skin.

DRAIN- Eliminate standing water sources around your home and workplace to prevent mosquito breeding.

DUSK TO DAWN- Reduce outdoor activity during peak mosquito hours.
