JANUARY 2025 NEWSLETTER



I'm excited to start this year with a focus on making Dallas County greener and more sustainable. At the end of 2024, Dallas County hired consultants to create a multiyear plan to transition our fuel fleet to electric vehicles. They combined data from several sources, analyzed 18 months of vehicle operations (like mileage, fuel use and maintenance costs) and reviewed 964 vehicles for electrification potential. Of these, 702 vehicles are suitable for electrification with current technology. Over nine years, transitioning these vehicles would cost \$49 million, including \$6 million for charging infrastructure. In the next four years, electrifying 135 of the vehicles with the highest investment returns could save \$1 million in operating costs, avoid 2,430 metric tons of CO2 emissions and conserve 286,000 gallons of gasoline. This analysis provides a clear path forward as we work together for a cleaner and more sustainable future.

January is National Slavery & Human Trafficking Awareness Month. Human trafficking is a form of modern-day slavery in which traffickers target vulnerable populations, including men, women, children, citizens and noncitizens, forcing them into servitude and/or the sex trade. Texas ranks second in the country for trafficking prevalence, with more than 300,000 annual victims statewide. In Dallas, an estimated 400 teens are sold for sex every night, as part of a \$99 million illegal industry. I am honored to be the Chair of New Life Opportunities, which serves to eliminate prostitution in Dallas County through the Solicitors and Traffickers Of Prostitution (STOP) School in partnership with the District Attorney's Office and other partners.

The U.S. News & World Report, which publishes hospital rankings and consumer advice, named Parkland Memorial Hospital as a 2025 high-performing hospital for maternity care.
