Family Law Forms at the Law Library

One of the greatest resources for the pro se litigant at the Dallas County Law Library is our extensive collection of Texas family law forms. The Law Library offers family forms found on **texaslawhelp.org** that involve **Divorce**, **Suit Affecting the Parent-Child Relationship** (*SAPCR*), **Modification**, **Name Change** and **Paternity**.

Library staff have printed out the complete set of forms for each type of case and included some specific Dallas County additions, such as the <u>Dallas County Standing Orders</u> and <u>Citation by Posting or</u> <u>Publishing</u> which can be found on the Dallas County <u>District Clerk's</u> website. The packets include extensive instructions and are fill-in-the-blank. Texas Law Help designed these forms for self-representing litigants and is "dedicated to providing free and reliable legal information to Texans."

Texaslawhelp.org has multiple legal resources and information and every page is now available in Spanish and Vietnamese. In addition to the <u>texaslawhelp.org</u> forms, the Law Library maintains a complete Texas family law collection in print. Library staff have printed out many of the frequently requested family forms for patrons to make copies of. These forms, such as the *Original Petition for Grandparent Possession or Access*, are templates that help patrons draft their own legal documents.

Patrons may also conduct their own research using the print collection, such as O'Connor's Family Law Forms and the State Bar of Texas Family Law Practice Manual.


