

PAYMENT OF FINES AND COURT COST

A Fine is part of the punishment for the Crime Committed. Court Cost is part of the expense of legally processing your case.

FAILURE to pay can result in Arrest and/ or Confinement. This can be considered a Violation of Probation.

A Warrant for your Arrest may be issued for Violation of any conditions of probation.

If issued, you will be held in the Dallas County Jail without bond unless otherwise ordered by the Judge.



GENERAL PROCESSING

IF YOU LEAVE WITHOUT MAKING PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS, YOU WILL BE IN VILOATION OF YOUR COURT ORDER AND SUBJECT TO ARREST.

No food or beverages are allowed in the waiting area.

Persons other than the defendant (friends, relatives, children, etc.) should wait for the defendant in the hall area.

Application

You must complete an application. The information on your application will be verified. Incomplete or inaccurate information will delay your processing.

Interview

You must be interviewed. During the interview, terms for payment will be established. Maximum payment terms usually do not exceed sixty (60) days.

Processing Time

Your application will be processed in the order it was received. Your name will be called for intereviewiong as soon as possible. Your patience is appreciated.

Questions

All of your questions regarding payment of your fines and court costs should be answered before you leave. During your interview is the time to clarify any and all question regarding payment of fines and court costs.
