LOCAL DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Dallas, Texas on 28th day of May 2024, is suffering widespread severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from severe weather, including strong wind, hail, flooding and flash flooding due to heavy rainstorms,

WHEREAS, such severe weather has created significant and widespread loss of electricity throughout the County of Dallas, which has also added to the loss of life or property (or the imminent threat of same),

WHEREAS, Clay Lewis Jenkins, the County Judge of Dallas County, Texas has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS:

- 1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Dallas County, Texas, pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- 2. Pursuant to section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Dallas County, Texas.
- 3. Pursuant to section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this *Local Declaration of Disaster* shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
- 4. Pursuant to section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this *Local Declaration of Disaster* activates the Dallas County emergency management plans.
 - 5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
