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PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING ON PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO SEAL COURT  
RECORDS AND FOR TEMPORARY SEALING ORDER

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Pursuant to Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 76a(3), Plaintiffs Synergy Thermogen, Inc. and Synergy Automation LLC (collectively "Plaintiffs" or "Synergy"), post this Public Notice of the hearing in open court on Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary and Permanent Sealing Orders as to redacted portions of Plaintiffs' Original Petition and certain of the accompanying exhibits, filed on March 26, 2025, in the above-styled case. The hearing will be held on **Monday June 16th, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. CST** and will take place before the Business Court of Texas, First Division. The hearing will be conducted at 8800 Park Lane, Dallas, Texas 75231 in the First Floor Conference Room.

The records sought to be sealed reflect Plaintiffs' proprietary financial and pricing information and confidential trade secrets, including its descriptions of its proprietary and patented

technology, marketing materials, revenue information, and sales strategies and information. The parties are not asking the Court to seal any court order or opinion.

On May 13, 2025, this Court signed a Temporary Sealing Order granting Plaintiffs leave to file the Plaintiffs' Original Petition and associated exhibits under seal.

Plaintiffs have filed an unredacted copy of Plaintiffs' Original Petition and associated exhibits with the Court and have served copies on the Parties to this lawsuit. For the reasons stated in Plaintiffs' Motion For Temporary and Permanent Sealing Orders, *inter alia*, that the Original Petition and certain of the accompanying exhibits contain financial details that reflect and could be used to ascertain both Synergy and Defendants sensitive commercial information and trade secrets, Plaintiffs now request the Court permanently seal the Plaintiffs' Original Petition and certain of the accompanying exhibits.

Any person may intervene and be heard concerning the sealing of the Arbitration Award.

A verified copy of this Public Notice will also be filed with the clerk of the court in which the case is pending and with the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Texas.
