

The Court finds that the customary and usual post-judgment turnover receiver fee is \_\_\_\_% of the funds recovered during the receivership, subject to a later determination as to the reasonableness by the Court or Judgment Defendant's written agreement before the fee is paid. The Receiver's fee taxed as costs against the Judgment Defendant. Because this is a post-judgment receivership pursuant CPRC 31.002, no bond is required. The Receiver is further ordered to take the oath of his office.
