Intercepted is rapidly growing and is currently looking for strong role models to mentor young first-time offenders who are headed in the wrong direction.

Requirements:

1. Attend three (3) court orientations within a nine -month period. Orientations last 45 mins.
2. Contact mentee by phone twice a month to encourage their participation and overall success.
 - a. Discuss career options and goals.
3. Correspond with the Intercepted team with any concerns regarding mentees participation in the program.

Qualifications:

1. Must not have any pending criminal cases.
2. Must not have any prior convictions within the past 7 years.
3. Must have driver's license and be employed.

Exclusions:

1. Do not give mentee any money or promises.
2. Do not provide mentee with any legal advice-all offenders have their own attorney.
3. Transportation is not necessary. Each treatment facility provides transportation or transportation passes.
