COURT'S ADMONITION CONCERNING FAMILY VIOLENCE CONVICTIONS

To the Defendant:

You are admonished that under Article 42.0131 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure as a defendant convicted of an offense in involving family violence, as defined by Section 71.004 of the Family Code, it is unlawful for you to possess or transfer a firearm or ammunition.
