Order Appointing John B. Peyton as Associate Judge and Master

The undersigned presiding judges of The Probate Court of Dallas County, Texas, Probate Court No. 2 of Dallas County, Texas and Probate Court No. 3 of Dallas County, Texas find that there is ample need for John B. Peyton (Texas State Bar #15878000) to serve and aid these Courts in various respects.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. John B. Peyton is appointed as an Associate Judge for the Probate Court of Dallas County, Texas, Probate Court No. 2 of Dallas County, Texas and Probate Court No. 3 of Dallas County, Texas pursuant to Section 54.603 et seq. of the Texas Government Code and is to have all powers and duties set forth in Section 54.610 of the Texas Government Code and in any Local Rules of The Dallas County Probate Courts. In general, this Associate Judge is empowered to hear and may be referred any aspect of a case over which these Courts have jurisdiction, including any matter ancillary to the case.
- 2. John B. Peyton is appointed Master pursuant to Section 574.0085 of the Texas Health & Safety Code and is to have all powers and duties set forth in Section 54.006 of the Texas Government Code and in any Local Rules of the Probate Courts of Dallas County, Texas. In general, this Master is empowered to hear and may be referred any case or any portion of a case brought under or in connection with proceedings for court-ordered mental health services.
