ORDER

Effective the first day of January, 2012 in all proceedings requiring the appointment of an attorney ad litem in which a filing fee is paid, a deposit for the fee for the attorney ad litem shall be paid at the time of filing. The attorney ad litem deposit shall be held by the County Clerk in an account, suitable for the purpose, to be disbursed to the attorney ad litem appointed in the case upon order of the court. The deposit shall be in the amount stated below.


Application for Guardianship-	\$ 400.00
Application for Determination of Heirship-	\$ 400.00

No case for which an attorney ad litem deposit is required will be heard by the Court until such deposit has been paid.


