Status Update on Fair Park Vaccine Operations

DALLAS –Vaccine operations have continued at Dallas County’s Fair Park drive-thru site this week following closures from last week’s winter weather event. In an effort to catch up on delayed second doses as soon as possible, Dallas County has released the following schedule. We ask all residents to please be patient as there are many who need their second dose and we must space out individuals to ensure timely and safe delivery.

DATE	HOURS OF OPERATION	Gate	ELIGIBILITY
Thursday, February 25	8am-5pm	8	Due for second dose on <u>Feb. 17</u> or earlier. Please plan to arrive around the same time you received your first dose.
Friday, February 26	9am-5pm	8	Due for second dose on <u>Feb. 22</u> or earlier. Please plan to arrive around the same time you received your first dose.
Saturday, February 27	9am-5pm	8	Due for second dose on <u>Feb. 23</u> or earlier. Please plan to arrive around the same time you received your first dose.
Sunday, February 28	CLOSED		
Monday, March 1	9am-5pm	8	Due for second dose on <u>Feb. 25</u> or earlier. Please plan to arrive around the same time you received your first dose.
Tuesday, March 2	9am-5pm	8	Due for second dose on <u>March 1</u> or earlier. Please plan to arrive around the same time you received your first dose.
Wednesday, March 3	9am-5pm	8	Due for second dose on <u>March 3</u> or earlier. Please plan to arrive around the same time you received your first dose.

The CDC guidance is that second doses of the vaccine may be administered up to 6 weeks after the first dose. While we plan to accommodate those needing a second dose much sooner than that, please know that the CDC does allow for a 42-day timeframe.
