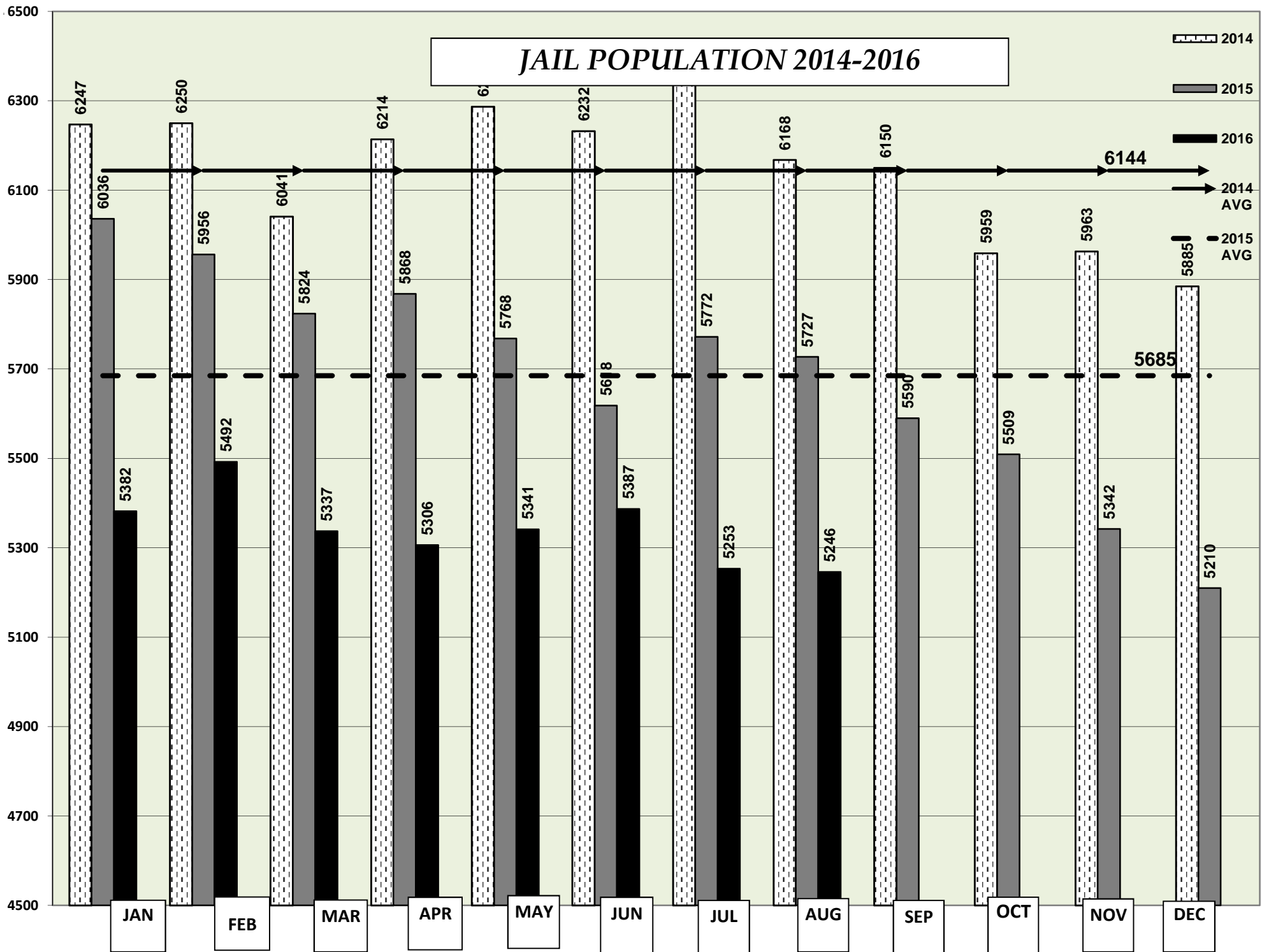

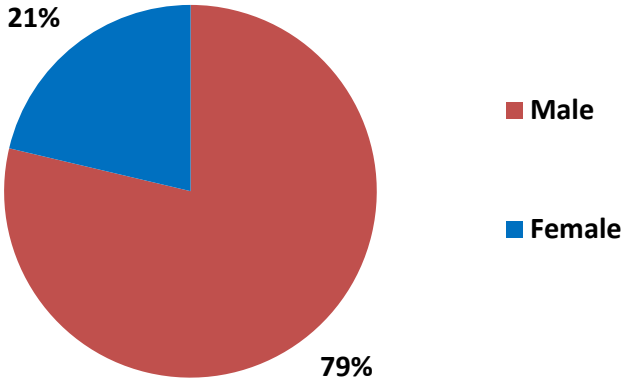

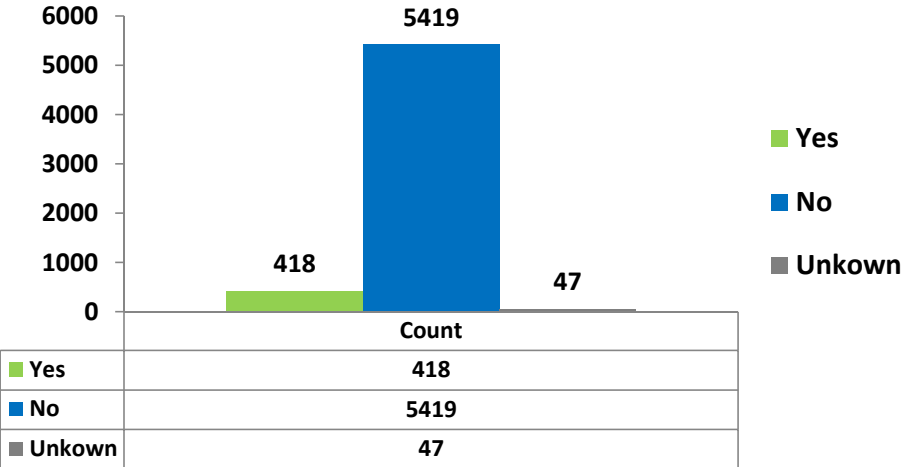

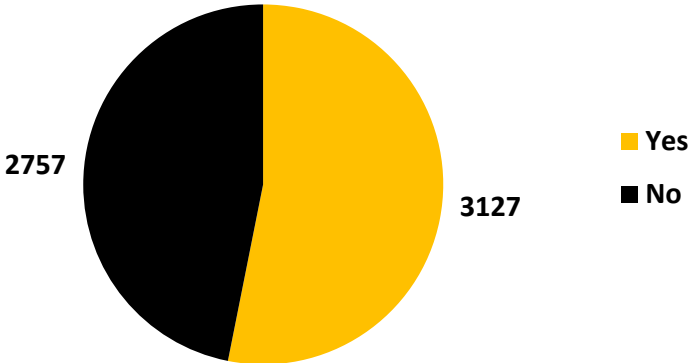
August 2016 BookIn Gender

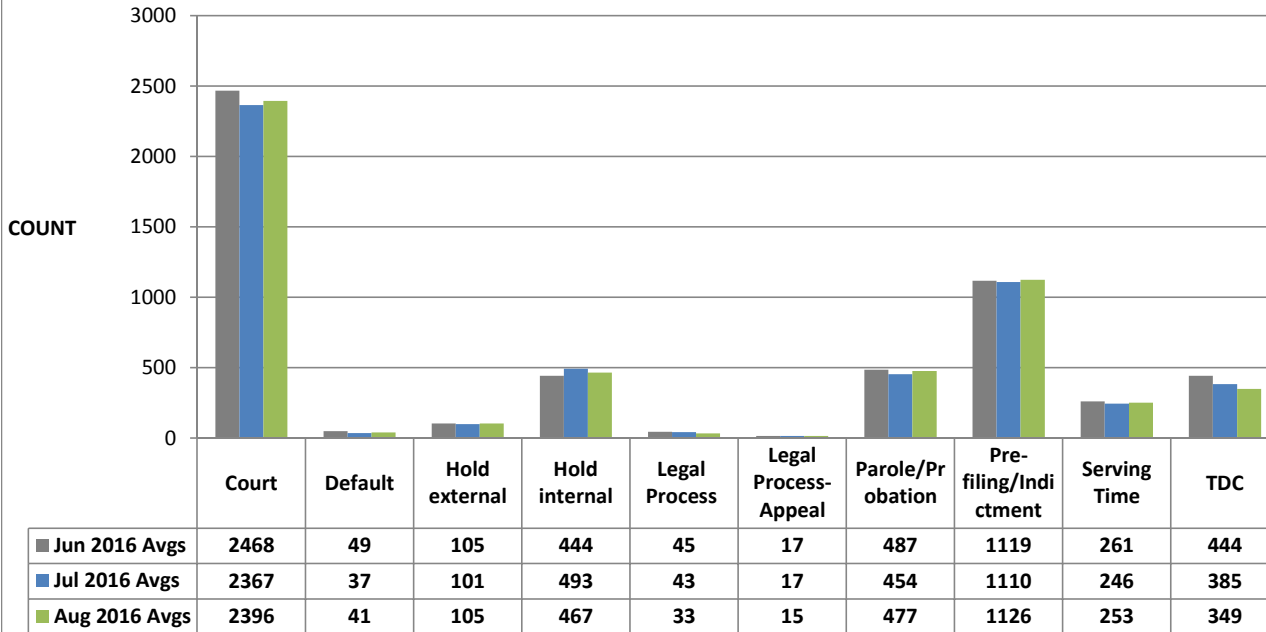

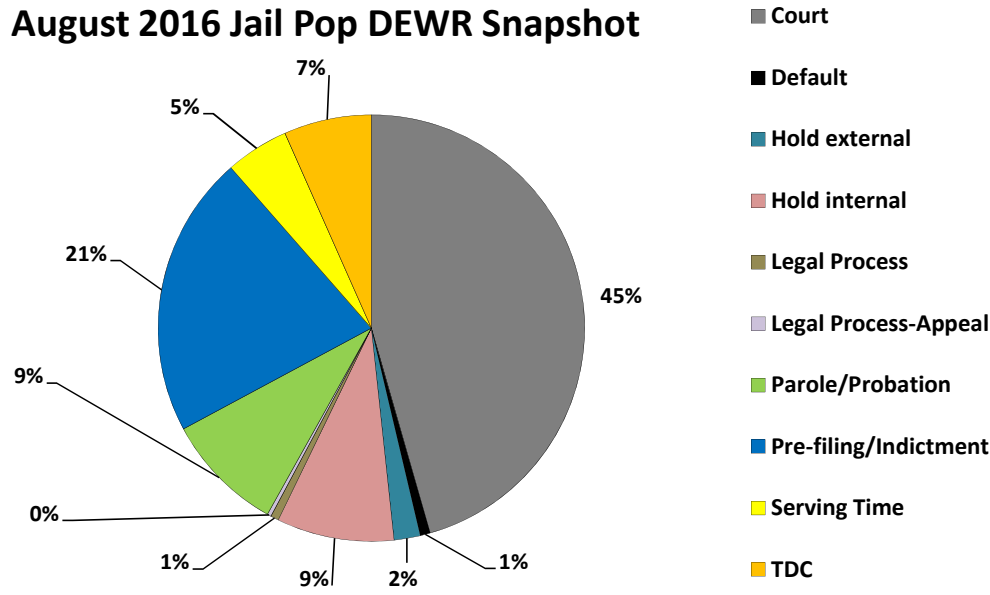

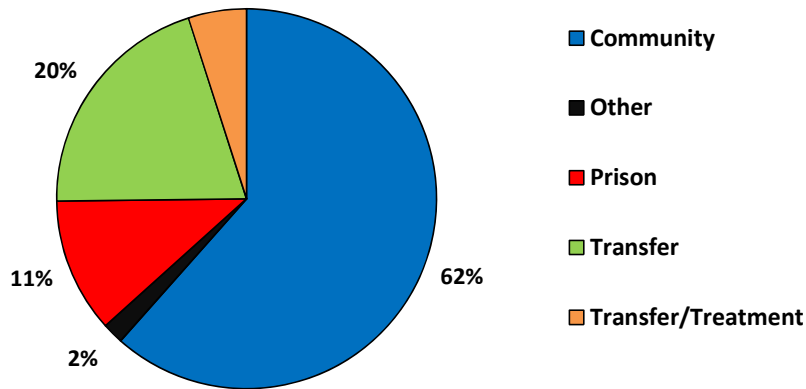

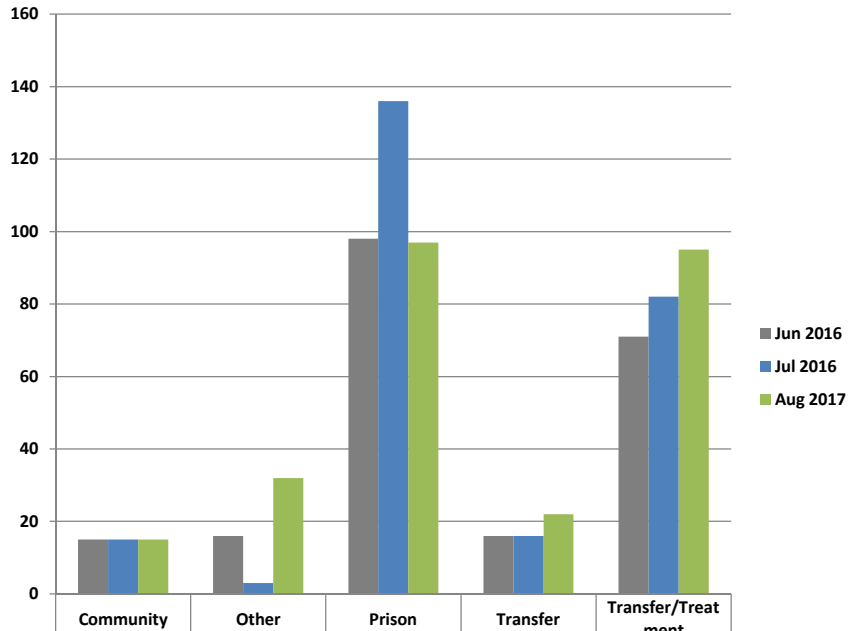
