

# Felony Pre-Trial Intervention (PTI) Agreement Resource Packet

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#### What is a Pre-Trial Intervention Agreement?

A Pre-Trial Intervention (PTI) Agreement is a special contract between you and the Dallas County District Attorney's Office. You agree to follow certain rules and complete specific conditions within an allotted timeframe. If you do everything you're supposed to do, the charges against you will be dropped, and you can erase your criminal record, so it won't stop you from getting a job, applying for public benefits, or renting an apartment.

#### What Type of PTI Agreement Did I Sign?

Look at your PTI Agreement to find out which type you have. It will be one of these:

- Supervised PTI through Community Supervision and Corrections Department (CSCD)
- Supervised PTI through CSCD Emerging Adult Caseload (EAC)
- Supervised PTI through Pre-Trial Services (PTS)
- Supervised PTI through Recovery Monitoring Solutions (RMS)
- Non-Supervised PTI

If you have a Supervised PTI, you'll have extra steps to follow, like meeting with a case manager. Here's what you need to do for each type:

# I. SUPERVISED (CSCD) FELONY PRE-TRIAL INTERVENTION (PTI) AGREEMENT SUPERVISED by Dallas County Supervision & Corrections

- 1. Review the Contract and Conditions: Look at what you agreed to do.
- 2. **Pay the CSCD Fee:** Take your PTI agreement and your Felony Personal Data Sheet ASAP to the Community Supervision window on the 8<sup>th</sup> floor to pay the \$102 probation fee. Both you and your attorney will need to go together to the 8th floor and pay the fee. After you get off the elevator, go through the door where the sign says "A"- Community Supervision (CSCD). Then, go to the first window on your left. That is the felony courts window.
- 3. Send the Fee Receipt and Contract: After paying, send the receipt and the signed agreement to PTI attorney at PTIAttorney@Dallascounty.org. Once received, the PTI ADA will sign and send an email to your attorney with your PTI expiration date and further instructions. Contact Your CSCD Case Manager: Within 5 business days of paying the fee, call 214-875-4878 or go to 1300 W Mockingbird Ln, 3rd Floor, Dallas, TX 75247 to set up a meeting with your Community Supervisor.
- 4. **Attend CSCD Appointments:** You must meet with your CSCD Case Manager every month and follow all the rules, like taking urine tests if needed. Missing appointments or positive UAs could result in termination of your contract.
- 5. **Proof of Conditions:** Please provide proof of completed conditions to your CSCD Case Manager. They will let us know if you have successfully completed your CSCD PTI Agreement. Half of your conditions are due at the midpoint date. All conditions must be submitted by 10AM on your PTI expiration date.

## II. SUPERVISED PTI through RMS FELONY PRE-TRIAL INTERVENTION (PTI) AGREEMENT INCLUDING DWI SUPERVISED by RECOVERY MONITORING SOLUTIONS

- 1. Review the Contract and Conditions: Look at what you agreed to do.
- 2. **You and your attorney will sign the PTI Contract:** After signing, send the contract to the PTI attorney at <u>PTIAttorney@Dallascounty.org.</u> Once received, the PTI ADA will sign and send an email to your attorney with your PTI expiration date and any further instructions.
- 3. **Schedule Orientation:** Call 214-819-1454 or email rms@recoveryms.com within 3 business days of signing your PTI to set up an orientation appointment. Bring your PTI Agreement to 9090 North Stemmons, Suite A, Dallas, TX 75247.
- 4. **Proof of Conditions:** Please provide all proof of completion of conditions to your RMS Case Manager. They will let us know if you have successfully completed your CSCD PTI Agreement. Half of your conditions are due at the midpoint date. All conditions must be submitted by 10AM on your PTI expiration date.

# III. Supervised PTI through EAC FELONY EMERGING ADULT CASELOAD (EAC) PRE-TRIAL INTERVENTION (PTI) AGREEMENT

- 1. Review the Contract and Conditions: Look at what you agreed to do.
- 2. Send the Fee Receipt and Contract: After you <u>and</u> your attorney sign the agreement and reporting instructions, you can email the forms back to the PTI attorney at <a href="https://example.com/PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org">PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org</a>. The prosecutor will sign and send an email to your attorney with your PTI expiration date and any further instructions.
- 3. Contact Your EAC Case Manager: Within 5 business days you must call 214-653-3472 or go to 1300 W Mockingbird Ln, 3rd Floor, Dallas, TX 75247 to set up a meeting. Your EAC Case Manager will be able to provide you more information regarding the payment fee for drug tests, meeting times, and the conditions you must complete.
- **4. Proof of Conditions**: Your EAC Case Manager will keep track of your conditions and let us know if you have successfully completed your EAC PTI Agreement. Half of your conditions are due at the midpoint date. All conditions must be submitted by 10AM on your PTI expiration date.

## IV. Supervised PTI through PTS FELONY PRE-TRIAL INTERVENTION (PTI) AGREEMENT SUPERVISED BY PRE-TRIAL SERVICES

- 1. Review the Contract and Conditions: Look at what you agreed to do.
- 2. Sign the PTI Agreement, the Pretrial Services PTI Reporting Instructions, and the PTS PTI Enrollment Form
- **5. Return the signed PTI Contract:** After you and your attorney sign the contract, send the contract to the PTI attorney@Dallascounty.org. Once received, the PTI ADA will sign and send an email to your attorney with your PTI expiration date and any further instructions.
- **3.** Make an appointment with your Case Manager: You are responsible for calling the Pretrial Services Unit at (214) 875-2302 to make the initial appointment with your assigned Pretrial

- Services Case Manager. Your Pretrial Services Reporting Instructions will determine if you are required to report in person or by phone.
- **4. Report to your PTS Case Manager Monthly:** You will be required to report as directed to your assigned Pretrial Services CM in the Frank Crowley Criminal Courts Building, 133 N. Riverfront Blvd. 8<sup>th</sup> floor, Dallas, TX 75207 Tel # (214) 875-2302. Office hours are Monday Friday from 8:00am 4:30pm. Your Pretrial Services Case Manager will schedule appointment dates and times.
- **5. Complete and provide proof of conditions:** You can provide conditions to your PTS case manager, or you can email them directly to <u>PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org</u>. You may also drop them off with the secretaries on the 11<sup>th</sup> floor window to the right and leave in the PTI tray. Half of your conditions are due at the midpoint date. All conditions must be submitted by 10AM on your PTI expiration date.

# V. Non-Supervised PTI NON-SUPERVISED FELONY PRE-TRIAL INTERVENTION (PTI) AGREEMENT

If you have a Non-Supervised PTI, you don't have a case manager. You need to complete all the conditions by yourself and keep your attorney updated. We will not be contacting you to assist with the conditions or set anything up for you. Please email proof of completion of conditions to <a href="PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org">PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org</a> or they can be delivered to the 11th floor with the secretaries in the PTI tray. At least half of your conditions are due by the midpoint date that was provided to your attorney. If you can submit all your conditions before your expiration date, that would be great. If submitting the conditions on the expiration date, please submit them no later than 10AM on the day of your expiration.

#### What Exactly Do I Have to Do Now?

The agreement lists specific things you must do before the end date. The checked boxes are the "conditions" of the PTI Agreement you must complete. If it includes taking classes, you must take the exact class stated on the agreement. You should start completing your tasks right after you sign the contract.

#### **How Long is My PTI Agreement?**

Your PTI Agreement can last 3, 6, 9, 12, or 18 months. The exact length is written on your contract.

#### What if I Finish Early?

Even if you finish early, your case won't be dismissed until the end date of the agreement in most cases.

#### What Happens if I Don't Finish?

If you don't complete all the tasks by the end date, you may be given an opportunity to complete another diversion program, or your case may be sent back to the trial court and go through the regular court processes.

#### **How Do I Make Payments?**

**PTI Program Fee**: MUST BE PAID IN PERSON ONLY. Bring your signed PTI Agreement to the Check Division at the Dallas County Criminal District Attorney's Office on the 11th floor of the Frank Crowley Courts Building. You may pay by cashier's check, money order, or credit card (with a fee). Cashier's check and money orders need to be payable to the "Dallas County". If using a credit/debit card, the cardholder must be present with ID to process the payment. You can pay in installments, but everything must be paid by the expiration date of your PTI. Please note, that the PTI Fee CANNOT be paid online at this time.

#### **Restitution**: You can pay online using the link below:

https://www.dallascounty.org/dcdaVelocity/restitution.jsp -Note, you must notify the PTI ADA at least 2 days before you pay online so that a restitution form can be filled out and submitted to the payment center. You can email <a href="mailto:PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org">PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org</a> to give notice. You may also pay in person on the 11th floor of the Frank Crowley Courts Building. If you choose to pay in person, you must bring your contract and indicate that the payment is for Restitution only.

#### What if I Can't Afford the PTI Fee?- See page 1 on the Waiver Application

**Before** signing your PTI Agreement, you can apply for a fee waiver or reduction. Email <a href="mailto:PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org">PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org</a> for the application form. This is a separate application form and unrelated to the indigency form you submitted to the court.

Please take the fee waiver application and a \$5 payment to the checks division on the 11<sup>th</sup> floor. Email your receipt and the waiver to the email listed above. Waivers will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

#### Will I Get My Money Back if I Don't Finish?

No, you won't get a refund if you don't complete the program.

#### Do I Still Have To Go to Court?

Having to appear in court while on a PTI varies from court to court. Stay in contact with your attorney so you know if the judge in your court is requiring you to appear for court hearings.

There is no need to meet in-person with the PTI Attorney as your conditions can be submitted to your case manager, the PTIAttorney email, or dropped off at the DA's window on the 11th Floor. If allowed by the court, please have the attorney pass the case with the trial court ADA to the mid-point or expiration date of your PTI.

#### Where Do I Send Proof When I Complete My Conditions?

- **Supervised PTI:** Give proof to your case manager.
- **Non-Supervised PTI:** Email <u>PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org</u> or drop off proof of documentation with the clerks at the ADA office on the 11<sup>th</sup> floor.

 Once all conditions have been completed, we will run an updated background check to see if you are eligible for dismissal, and will email the dismissal to your defense attorney on your expiration date.

#### **Need Help Getting an ID?**

The Stewpot (1835 Young Street, Dallas, TX, 214.746.2785, Info@thestewpot.org) can help. They are open Monday – Friday at 8 am. Bring any documents you have.

#### **How Do I Confirm Employment?**

Submit a pay stub, W-2, or a letter from your employer.

#### **How Do I Confirm Education?**

Submit a letter of enrollment or a class schedule with your name and dates.

#### How Do I Sign Up for a Required Class?

Choose any agency, but make sure the class meets the requirements (like the Drug Offender Education Program being 15 hours). A list of recommended agencies is at the end of this document.

#### What if I Need Urine Tests (UAs)?

If you are on a CSCD, RMS, or EAC PTI, the number of UAs will be determined by your case manager. If you are on a PTS or Non-Supervised PTIs and are required to submit UAs, note that in order to satisfy this condition you must submit a standard 5-panel UA. If your contract includes a no\_alcohol condition, you must also include ETG on your UA. Please pay attention to how many UA tests you must submit. If you are required to give UAs, **they must be at least 3 weeks apart**. You may use any lab for testing, but not a self-collection kit. Two labs you can use are Recovery Monitoring Solutions or Sentinel Offender Services listed below:

Instructions: Form for RMS UA is attached. Must be completed by defense attorney. Form needs to be marked "self-pay" and the UA costs \$50. If you provide a physical copy of your PTI Agreement to RMS, they will **reduce** your UA cost to \$19.00. Send completed form to: <u>drugtesting@recoveryms.com</u>, then you can present to RMS, pay, and submit UA.

<u>Sentinel Offender Services</u> - Frank Crowley Courts Building 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, 214-741-6045 <u>sentineldallas@sentrack.com</u>

Instructions: Form for a Sentinel UA is attached. Must be completed by the defense attorney and submitted to Sentinel in person on the 8th floor, Suite 8123 next to the Criminal Justice Department. Defendant can submit payments (costs listed on form, but generally \$22 for regular drug screen and \$25

to include alcohol) by cash, money order, or debit/credit card. Must have valid ID to submit UA, also must have a copy of COB/Court Order for Sentinel records.

#### Can I Use a Drug Patch Instead?

Yes, if your PTI Agreement specifically says "UAs or drug patches" you can wear a drug patch for 3 consecutive drug patches (unless specified otherwise). You will need to change the drug patch every 10-14 days and submit the results to <a href="mailto:ptiattorney@dallascounty.org">ptiattorney@dallascounty.org</a>. Two places that offer drug patch services are Recovery Monitoring Solutions and Integrated Psychotherapy Services. If using RMS, please bring a copy of your PTI Agreement with you to their location. You will need to designate

<a href="mailto:ptiattorney@dallascounty.org">PTIAttorney@dallascounty.org</a> to receive the UA or drug patch results.

#### What if I Have to Do Community Service Hours?

Find a legitimate organization like a church, animal shelter, or charity. Get written proof of your service. Individual or non-organization hours **will not** be accepted. Canned food donations will not be accepted.
