**COURT ORDER TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL LAWS REGARDING FIREARM POSSESSION
IN CASES INVOLVING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE**

The Defendant, having been convicted in this domestic violence case, is subject to federal law which places a life-time ban on the Defendant from possessing any firearms. To ensure compliance with federal law, the Court hereby ORDERS:

1. No later than _____ at _____, Defendant must offer proof that he/she has complied with 18 U.S.C. §922(g).
2. To prove compliance with federal law, the Defendant shall either:
 - a. Permanently Surrender the firearm(s) listed in (4) below to DFW Gun Range and then present the receipt from DFW Gun Range to the Court no later than the date and time named in (1) above.
 - b. Permanently forfeit or sell the firearm(s) listed in (4) below to a third-party that:
 - i. Has a federal license to purchase firearms and is approved by the Court; or
 - ii. Appears in court with the Defendant on or before the date and time named in (1) above and:
 1. States in-court and under oath that they understand the criminal liability involved in granting possession of a firearm or ammunition to the above-named Defendant; and
 2. Passes a federal firearm background check (available at DFW Gun Range) (expenses to be incurred by the Defendant or third-party).
3. **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS ORDER WILL RESULT IN THE FILING OF FEDERAL CRIMINAL CHARGES, VIOLATION OF PROBATION, CONTEMPT OF COURT CHARGES, OR ALL OF THE ABOVE.**
