Beat the Back-to-School Rush, Get Your Children Immunized Now

DALLAS (July 19, 2019) - Dallas County Health and Human Services (DCHHS) is urging all parents/guardians to get their children immunized now before the back-to-school rush. DCHHS has seven clinics open Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. to help parents kick off the new school year.

"It is so important to make sure your children are vaccinated on time to ensure their long term health", said Dr. Philip Huang, DCHHS Director. "Vaccinations also help protect the health of classmates, friends, relatives, and others in the community. Make sure to get your kids any needed vaccines before the back-to-school rush!"

Come visit any of our seven immunizations clinic locations and no appointment is needed. The cost for Texas Vaccine for Children (TVFC) eligible immunizations is \$10 for the child's first visit and \$5 for returning patients. Waivers are granted to families in need.

College students are also able to get state required meningitis vaccine at any of the DCHHS clinics. Without the vaccine, they cannot enter college. Those students include anyone who is a first-time student of a public, private or independent institution of higher education, transfer student or a student who previously attended an institution of higher education before January 1, 2012 who is now enrolling again following a break in enrollment.
