Dallas County Health and Human Services Hosts Annual Back-to-School Vaccine Event

Dallas (August 5, 2025) –Dallas County Health and Human Services (DCHHS) is pleased to announce its annual Back-to-School Vaccine Event on Saturday, August 9, 2025. The event will be held at the DCHHS building located at 2377 N. Stemmons Fwy., Dallas, Texas 75207, from 9 a.m. to noon.

Last year, this important community event successfully served over 200 children, providing essential vaccinations to ensure a healthy start to the school year. This year, DCHHS aims to expand its impact and reach even more families in need of vaccination services.

“We are committed to ensuring every child in Dallas County has access to crucial vaccinations as they prepare to return to school,” says Dr. Phil Huang, Director of DCHHS. “These vaccines are critical in safeguarding our children's health and preventing the spread of preventable diseases within our community.”

All attendees needing vaccines are required to bring immunization records. Children aged 17 and under must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. The cost will be \$10 for the first visit and \$5 for all subsequent visits. However, no one will be turned away for the inability to pay. Families with private insurance should contact their primary physician to obtain their immunizations. Walk-ins are accepted; appointments are strongly preferred.
