Basic Eligibility Requirements:

- U.S. Citizen or Legal Status
 - Disabled (must show medical documentation)
- 18 Years or Older
- Not receiving housing assistance (e.g., Section 8)
- Dallas County Resident
- Limited Income/Resources

Required Documentation (Bring to Your Appointment):

- Government-issued Photo ID or Driver's License
- Social Security Cards (for all household members)
- Medical Statement (signed by licensed provider within 30 days)
 - Must include diagnosis, prognosis, and disability dates
- Proof of ALL income (last 30 days)

- Proof of Social Security application (if applicable)
- Proof of U.S. citizenship or legal residency
- Bank activity: Checking/Savings/Debit Card printouts
- All utility bills (current)
- Full signed Lease Agreement or current Mortgage Statement
