Qualifications

The minimum requirements for the exam are as follows: (all required work experience must be with the Dallas County Sheriff's Department). Must have successfully maintained all State and Sheriff's office licensing/commissioning requirements and the following:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Served at least two (2) years as a Dallas County Sheriff's Deputy IV - (Lieutenant) and have at least sixty (60) hours of college from an accredited college or university with a grade "C" or better in each class OR
- Served at least two (2) continuous years as a Dallas County Sheriff's Deputy IV - (Lieutenant), two (2) years of continuous military service with honorable discharge and have at least thirty (30) hours of college from an accredited college or university with a grade "C" or better OR
- Served six (6) continuous years as a Dallas County Sheriff's Deputy IV - (Lieutenant)

Required Documents

- Completion of an online application in its entirety on Dallas County's Employment Site
- Valid Texas Driver's License with a good driving record
- A copy of college transcript(s), if applicable
- A copy of your DD214, if military experience is going to be substituted
